City Manager Cornwall read a letter from Lloyce Robinson, Town Manager of Youngtown into the record.

As an enthusiastic regional partner, Youngtown appreciates collaboration with interested parties on the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community land.

The SRPMIC land lies within Youngtown's General Planning area giving Youngtown a vested interest.

The access from the Youngtown side of the river is superior; the Agua Fria Parkway fronts this property for almost 8/10s of a mile north from Olive Avenue to Peoria Avenue.

The ability to work with El Mirage on a future river crossing is vital for the development of this area.

The Town of Youngtown looks forward to partnering with the City of El Mirage for the mutual benefit of both communities.
