The City's proposed General Plan has been selected as a finalist in the LIVABLE COMMUNITIES, Public Policy/Plans category of Valley Forward's 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Environmental Excellence Awards program.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday in El Mirage kicks off next week, September 16<sup>th</sup> at the El Mirage Civic and Cultural Center. There will be art exhibits, live entertainment, samples of food and the opportunity to visit working artists' studios and art galleries.

At the last meeting, I was tasked with reviewing the possible merging of the Community Development and Economic Development Departments. That is currently under review and when completed, a report will be presented to the Council.

## VIII. ADJOURNMENT


