Minutes

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Lana Mook at 5:00 p.m.

II. ROLL CALL

III. WORK SESSION

1. Presentation on the newly developed Pavement (street) Maintenance program. (Public Works)

Larry Dobrosky and Robert Senita presented a brief presentation on the newly develop street pavement maintenance program and the history of the development program including the use of the Mineral Bond treatment. The plan is a general guideline and will be updated annually.

2. Discussion of Judge James Mapp and the City's budget. (Mayor & Council)

Mayor Mook stated that even that she is supporter of the Judge and the Court; she was disappointed in regards to the behavior and the lack of respect that was shown at the last meeting. She was also disappointed in the lack of clarity and accountability involving the budget of the Court.

Interim City Attorney Hall reported that there is a separation of the Judicial and Executive Branches but there are not clear lines to do the fact that the Court is a

part of the City Code; that the City provides funding to the Court and that the Court is responsible to the City for budgetary items.

Vice Mayor Shapera, Councilors Delgado, McPhetres, Palladino, Ramirez and Selby expressed their disappointment in regards to the behavior and the lack of respect that was shown at the last meeting.

Mayor Mook adjourned the meeting 6:17 p.m.


