# Mayor's message: Where your taxes go

**The City has slashed its budget by \$21.7 million while delivering improved police and fire services, upgraded streets, new public safety facilities, and a recreation facility with pool.**

While many cities and towns are still struggling to afford new capital projects and maintain staffing levels, the City of El Mirage has addressed such matters by concentrating on needs-based decision making, cost consciousness, and a desire to make El Mirage a destination.

El Mirage's current debt is 100% voter approved and does not rely on sales tax revenues for repayment. Additionally, the City has a fully funded capital improvements plan and continues to maintain a minimum \$6 million rainy day fund. Utility rates are stable and are anticipated to remain unchanged for the next five years.

At right is a graph depicting the sales tax per capita of several West Valley cities. As the graph illustrates, El Mirage has the lowest per capita sales tax among all cities noted. El Mirage relies on property taxes more than some other cities as we currently do not have the businesses necessary to generate adequate sales tax revenue. One of the reasons that the City is currently involved in several road projects is to attract those businesses. Developers have indicated that improved roadways, an attractive cityscape, and good amenities are key components for attracting the businesses we need.

In response to the questions I receive most frequently about property taxes and their uses, the following Q & A is provided for your information:

**Q: Where do my property taxes go?**

A: The largest share of your property taxes, 58%, is not City related but is collected for schools and education, which include the Dysart Unified School District, Dysart Unified Bonds, Dysart Unified Override, the Community College District, Community College District Bonds, the State Equalization Tax, and West-MEC.

Another 13% of your property taxes are allocated to the County for the Central Arizona Water Conservation District, Election District, Fire District Assistance Tax, Flood Control of Maricopa County, Library

District, Maricopa Special Health District, and McMicken Irrigation District.

The needs of our own City account for only 29% of your tax bill. This 29% can only be used to pay for voter-approved debt, and police and fire services to keep residents safe per Council Resolution.

The chart at right is a summary of the property tax allocations presented above.

**Q: How much of the City budget do my property taxes represent?**

A: The majority of the City's budgeted revenue comes from grants, fees, and revenues shared with the City by the State of Arizona. Property taxes are about five percent of the City budget.

**Q: How does the City use my primary property tax dollars?**

A: Under Arizona's two-tiered

property tax system, primary or "limited" property taxes provide general funds for basic government services. El Mirage has dedicated the entire amount of primary property taxes to police and fire services.

The El Mirage City Council

which could, depending on a property's assessed value, result in a lower tax bill. However, if your property's assessed value has increased more than the average home, then the tax bill could be higher.

**Q: Why does the City of El Mirage have a secondary property tax and other cities don't? What is the secondary property tax used for?**

A: If a municipality has no outstanding bonds, it will not levy a secondary property tax since this is the only purpose for which secondary property tax revenues can be used.

El Mirage levies a secondary property tax to pay for voter-approved bonds, which include funding for the fire station, police station, recreation facility with pool, and El Mirage Road improvements.


Under Arizona Revised Statute §35-458, El Mirage is required to levy a secondary property tax in an amount sufficient to pay our bond principal and interest.

The City has worked hard to keep the secondary property tax to a minimum. The Mayor, City Manager, and staff presented in person to the bond rating agencies of Moody's and Standard and Poor's in order to get the best bond rating possible at the time the bonds were sold. The resulting A1 and A+ ratings we received are expected to save the City approximately \$1.3 million in interest on new and existing bonds. Additionally, El Mirage was able to take advantage of lower interest rates to refund some higher rated bonds, thereby reducing the bond payments.

**Q: What is the difference between the Tax Levy and the Tax Rate?**


A: Tax LEVY: Total amount of taxes that need to be collected to operate the City. The City approves the tax levy, not the tax rate. The Council has maintained the tax levy for FY 2015 at the same amount as FY 2014.

Tax RATE: Individual dollar rate per hundred dollars of assessed value of a given property that is used to calculate a yearly tax bill. The rate is set by the County Assessor based on the tax levy and assessed property values. Under this Council, the overall property tax rate for FY 2015 has decreased

by \$0.50 from \$4.04 to \$3.54.

**Q: Why can't the City just keep my taxes exactly the same as they were last year?**

**A:** Property taxes cannot remain the same each year, primarily because property tax rates are based on property values which are affected by market conditions. Currently, property values are on an upward trend. The City has issued voter-approved bonds for facilities and infrastructure which must be repaid on schedule, much like a homeowner's mortgage, so the secondary rate will vary based on how much property values have changed.

The Council also reviews the revenue needs for operations and adjusts the primary rate to help meet those needs, while keeping the

primary property tax levy within the legal limit.

In any given year, any of these numbers could go up, go down, or stay the same. It is not legally possible to assign a flat tax to every property in El Mirage in order for the City portion of your property taxes to remain exactly the same each year.

I hope this information has helped clarify what property taxes are and how they are used to benefit the citizens of El Mirage.

Through good management, this Council has cut the budget \$21.7 million while delivering on our promise to build a police station, build a recreation facility with pool, and upgrade city streets. This Council has significantly increased services for our residents while decreasing the budget.



### Back to School Traffic Patrols

It's "Back to School Time" and the El Mirage Police Department is ready.

Officers regularly conduct traffic patrols in school zones in an effort to ensure the safety of students.

### Fire Department Awarded Two Grants

The El Mirage Fire Department received news of two grant awards during the month of July. The first award of over \$7,100 came from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for four

temperature-controlled pharmaceutical cases designed to be carried in the department's emergency vehicles. The cases offer important protection against Arizona's extreme temperatures for life-saving

medications. Notice of the second grant award came from the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation. The foundation is awarding the fire department a hand-held, state-of-the-art thermal imaging camera

valued at an estimated \$10,000. The new camera will offer highly enhanced visibility to firefighters in search of victims, and will help locate fire sources in very low visibility environments.

### 2 Seconds Is Too Long! Pool Safety Information

The summer months are here and many people are enjoying their residential swimming pools. As enjoyable as they are, they can also present a dangerous hazard to infants, children, and adults.

According to the Drowning Prevention Coalition of Arizona, there were 43 water related fatalities in 2013 in Maricopa County alone.

As of July 6th of this year, there have already been 29 water related fatalities, with 11 of those being children.

Here are some drowning risk factors to consider. If two or more of these factors exist, the risk of water related incidents increases significantly:

- New Parents/ Caregivers
- New owners of a pool

- Multiple children around the pool

- Lack of barriers (fences) or safety precautions around the pool (No toys, climbable furniture, ladders, etc. near fence or pool)

- Other water hazards around the home without safety features (buckets, bathtubs, toilets, etc.)

- Underestimate the mobility and ability of a toddler

- Breakdown in supervision or a lack of

focus when children are present

The City of El Mirage will be offering its curbside bulk trash pickup to residents of El Mirage who receive City-provided solid waste services this coming fall. The City's curbside bulk trash collection event held earlier this year was a great success. A new bulk trash collection event is scheduled beginning Monday, Oct. 27 and goes through Monday, Nov. 17.

Be aware the collection process utilizes large equipment and tools. To prevent any property damage and assist in the collection process, residents should ensure

that items are NOT placed near or against water meters, utility boxes, mail boxes, fire hydrants, fences, vehicles, landscaping, or in alleyways. When items are blocked or are hard to reach, crews have difficulty removing them, increasing collection times and the cost of the collection program.

Below are some examples of how NOT to place items out for collection.

Do not stack on or near fire hydrant.



Do not stack or lean against fence.



Bag all loose trash and/or debris.
