Mayor's Message: Sustaining the Police K9 Unit

In recent weeks, the El Mirage Police Department's K9 Officer, Dax, was diagnosed with hip dysplasia. According to the ASPCA, the inherited condition results from an improperly formed hip joint, causing painful wear and tear as it progresses. The condition commonly affects larger breeds of dogs, and in many cases, becomes visible during a dog's middle or later years.

Dax, a 4-year-old Belgian Malinois certified by the National Police Canine Association, has been a valued member of the police department since May 2012. Together with his handler Officer Doug Jones, Dax has been involved in more than 150 drug investigations, many resulting in seizure and arrest. Dax has had a positive impact on officer safety by participating in more than 80 patrol situations. In many cases, Dax's mere presence has resulted in compliance, making safety paramount.

Dax's favorite role, by far, has been that of a goodwill ambassador for the police department and City. Dax



loves to have interaction with children during classroom presentations. He participates at PTA, HOA, and City functions. Dax's drug awareness presentations allow children of all ages to interact and understand the value of good choices.

News of the police dog's dysplasia means the police department must now

plan for Dax's retirement from service. In addition, the department must deal with the unexpected costs of acquiring and training another certified police dog.

According to Police Chief Steve Campbell, "We regretfully anticipate having to retire Dax in the next four to five months, depending on his physical health. Quality police service dogs

can range from \$8,000 to \$10,000."

The importance of sustaining our City's K9 unit cannot be overstated. Therefore, I would ask your help during the coming months to ensure a new police dog can be purchased in the very near future. Beginning in December, the City will launch a donation campaign,

allowing interested residents to contribute toward acquisition of a new police dog. These efforts may include a donation request form in future issues of the El Mirage News; a similar form in residents' monthly water

billing; and donation bins at City facilities. I feel these efforts, coupled with the City's own search for grants and other funding options, will continue to sustain the unique protections a K9 officer provides our police personnel.

El Mirage Recognized in Two Best of the West Categories

The 22nd Annual Best of the West Awards ceremony took place Nov. 5 at Phoenix International Raceway. The awards are presented by the Western Maricopa Coalition (WESTMARC), a public/private partnership of 15 communities, including

El Mirage, as well as the business and education sectors in the West Valley of Greater Phoenix.

El Mirage was recognized in two award categories. The first award in the "economic engine" category was presented to a partnership

consisting primarily of El Mirage, Glendale, Peoria, Luke Air Force Base, and the Arizona Department of Transportation. The awarded project—Northern Parkway: Phase One—received top honors for bringing the West Valley a step closer

to linking the Loop 303 to Loop 101 and eventually U.S. 60. The parkway is expected to open doors to many new commercial and industrial opportunities for the West Valley economy.

The City's second award came in the "quality of life

enhancement" category. El Mirage received an honorable mention for the new Northwest Valley Family YMCA. This award acknowledged the City's unique partnership with the YMCA, which brings a broad spectrum of social

and human services to the West Valley. The award announcement highlighted the YMCA's pivotal role in giving children a place of safety, interaction, and acceptance, in addition to an enriched quality of life for every age group.

CUP volunteers on Make A Difference Day

Over the past 20 years, the fourth Saturday in October has been designated as Make A Difference Day, the largest national day of community service. This year in El Mirage, over 70 volunteers came forward to improve the lives of several community members. Volunteers from Reveal Church, Surprise Apostolic Church, Dysart High School Key Club, Valley Vista Fire Sciences, El Mirage City staff, and other caring individuals painted and cleaned properties.

The following projects were done by the volunteers:

- Landscape clean up at 4 properties
- Painted trim at two houses

- Painted one entire house, including doing trim work
- Installed landscaping at one property (all donated by Keven's Landscape Company)
- Installed address numbers at one property
- Performed a termite inspection at one property
- Painted the interior of Dysart Community Center

properties to work on, recruiting volunteers, and organizing the crews. The CUP tool trailer (custom designed by LOOK Trailers of El Mirage) had a busy day carting tools from site to site. Raymond Flores, of RNK Custom Homes donated many labor hours preparing a house for painting. Custom landscaping was done at one house completely donated by Keven's Landscape Company, another generous El Mirage business. A

termite inspection was donated to one concerned homeowner by Don Waller of No Problems Pest Control.

Special thanks go out to the El Mirage Firefighters Charities who generously prepared lunch for all the volunteers after their hard work was done.

The City of El Mirage currently has several garden boxes available for yearly lease at the Community Garden at the southeast corner of El Mirage and Thunderbird Roads. Available boxes are 17' long x 8' wide and lease for \$80 a year. Lease fee covers water, garden soil, general site maintenance, and seeds. Individuals, families, and groups are eligible to apply.



El Mirage PD Receives Honorable Mention for Excellence in Victim Services

On October 27, 2014, the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) and LogIn, Inc. announced the winners of the 2014 Excellence in Victim Services Award: The award recognizes law enforcement agencies that have developed and implemented

innovative strategies for providing comprehensive services to victims of crime.

The El Mirage Police Department received an Honorable Mention for the Victim Assistance Initiative in the Small Agency category.

The El Mirage Police

Department has made it a priority to have services available for crime victims. Over the last three years, the department created sustainable change and improved service delivery to victims of crime in the community, as well as across the State of Arizona.

the internal collaboration efforts, as well as that of many of its criminal justice partners. The department's collaborative movement within the law enforcement and criminal justice arena has closed many gaps in service delivery both locally and statewide.

El Mirage Police Awarded Traffic Enforcement Grant

The El Mirage Police Department has been awarded a grant through the Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) to fund traffic related enforcement projects for 2014/2015. The department received approximately \$15,000 to pay for El Mirage officers to participate in DUI Task Force events during the next year. Police agencies from around the Phoenix area join efforts to provide saturated DUI patrols to combat the prevalence of impaired driving throughout the

year. The Department also received \$3,000 from GOHS to purchase new breathalyzer machines for use in analyzing DUI's. An additional \$16,000 was awarded to implement new software that will help identify and analyze collision and crime trends.

The El Mirage Police Department is thankful to the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety for awarding these grants. This funding is vital toward improving traffic safety on city streets.

EMPD Explorers Earn Awards

themselves in a disciplined and professional manner while networking with other explorer posts and displaying a strong senses of purpose and teamwork. The Explorers also testified in front of Marana's judge on a domestic violence scenario.

Congratulations to EMPD Explorers who placed second in the tug-

of-war event and third in report writing and courtroom testimony. The post is less than a year old and competed against groups much larger and more established which makes this award an even greater accomplishment.
